PSYCHOLOGY HONORS CONTRACT REQUIREMENTS

In order to graduate with a major in Psychology and Honors in the Arts and Sciences, a student must have an Honors Contract signed by Dr. Alisa Paulsen or Dr. Lisa Cravens-Brown, Psychology Honors Advisors, and approved by the Arts and Sciences Honors Committee. Honors students beginning at Ohio State in AU22 or later follow the same content and credit hour requirements as non-Honors students. However, Psychology Honors students are strongly encouraged to take Psychology 1100H and are expected to select challenging psychology coursework, including Psychology Honors courses.

Within the psychology major, honors students must take at least 4 psychology honors courses (2000 to 5000-level, EXCLUDING the honors thesis course).

Psychology Honors students who entered OSU prior to AU22 should discuss psychology honors contract requirements with their psychology honors advisor.

Honors students must meet with their Psychology Honors Advisor by the end of their sophomore year to finalize their psychology curriculum and thereafter at least once a year to discuss progress in the major and changes to their major plan. Students can schedule an appointment through OnCourse.

Once a psychology honors curriculum has been approved, students must have changes **PREAPPROVED** by their Psychology Honors Advisor.

MINORING IN PSYCHOLOGY

Honors students minoring in Psychology follow the same content requirements as non-Honors students. However, we strongly encourage Honors students minoring in Psychology to select challenging coursework in Psychology, including at least one upper-level Psychology Honors course (2000-level through 5000-level). Honors students are not permitted to count a course on their psychology minor and also on their major.
